The Waitangi National Trust manages the Waitangi Treaty Grounds and the assets associated with them on behalf of all New Zealanders. The Treaty Grounds, New Zealand's premier historical site where the Treaty of Waitangi was signed in 1840, were gifted to the nation in 1932 by Lord and Lady Bledisloe. At the same time the Trust Board, which

represents various communities within the nation, was set up to further understanding of the Treaty of Waitangi, to present the grounds and their treasures to visitors both national and international, and to have responsibility for the financial management of the organization. There is no financial assistance from the Government and income is predominantly from entry fees. The Trust is currently engaged in a comprehensive development policy for the site, including the building of a new museum and education centre.

The Haven of History is a charitable trust focused on pursuing recognition of the Paihia Mission, which was founded in 1823 when Henry and Marianne Williams and the Fairburn family established it on behalf of the Church Missionary Society. Williams soon became the dominant figure amongst the missionaries and established good relations with local Maori, while, while his brother William was the key figure in translating the Bible into Maori. Other key figures in Early New Zealand history also spent time there. The Mission became the most influential European settlement in New Zealand in the lead-up to the Treaty of Waitangi, with a long list of 'firsts' in New Zealand history. The long-term goal of the Haven of History is to create a memorial to the Mission with its bi-cultural structure on its current site at 28 Marsden Road. Our long term goal is to protect over a quarter of this forest and to see flocks of kaka and kukupa return to the back yards of Paihia, along with a steady increase in kiwi. With support we hope to also see the return of kakariki, NI Robin and bellbirds too.

There has been a new beginning for Paihia School and some exciting events. These include a new Principal, our own Commonwealth Games, a visit from some All Blacks, Speech Competition, Pet Day, Talent Quest, Gala and a trip to the Outdoors Pursuit Centre in Tonagariro. Students have successfully participated in sporting competitions in netball, rugby, swimming, athletics, rippa

rugby, cross country, soccer, and hockey. The whole school participates in kapa haka every week. We believe it is essential that each child has the skills, knowledge and resources to succeed today and in their future. Our current mission statement says ‘Together we learn and prepare for the future’.

The current school roll is approximately 186, and has been on the increase over the past few years. The school is classified as a Decile 4 school. The school’s ethnic composition is comprised of 55% Māori, 35% New Zealand European and 10% from other ethnic groups. Children attending Paihia School come from a wide variety of social and economic backgrounds, due to the unique nature of the population in the Paihia area. Our children come from the Paihia, Waitangi, Opuā and Haruru Falls

The school also has a Library, Wharenui, Solar heated swimming pool, adventure playgrounds and large playing field.

We have nine great teachers at Paihia School. We also have six hard working teacher aides to support students. Shirley Kingi has been managed the library ‘forever’ and was a fabulous queen at the opening ceremony for our Commonwealth Games. Our caretaker, Terry Halliday has been at Paihia School for 31 years and never had a day off sick. He keeps our school grounds looking great and the field looking like a park. The friendly voice and warm smile when calling or visiting Paihia School is our office administrator Andre Simm. We opened another new entrant class half way through the year as our roll had grown so much. Pre-schoolers are more than welcome to visit Paihia School when they are nearly five. Our visiting day is every Thursday from 9.00am until 11.00am.

At Paihia School we are aware that within a few years all secondary school examinations will be done digitally. We have a responsibility to prepare our learners for the 21st Century. Today’s child likes being creative, having choice about what they learn and when. They like sight, sound and motion.

One way we can cater for our students’ future is through providing a future orientated learning environment that enables all our children to have equitable access to a device for their learning. In order to achieve this our senior students (Years 5 – 8) have the option in 2015 to own their own Chromebook. These will be paid off by parents over three years at the affordable rate of around \$3.50 per week.



This tool will allow our students to access their learning anywhere at anytime – not just while they are at school. Parents and families will be able to be part of their child’s learning every day. Staff and students are very excited about this initiative.
